

## **Log of applications and E-SEE study information distributed**

Health visitors and all those with contact in the early postnatal period have an important role in telling families about the E-SEE study and encouraging parents of babies aged 0-8 weeks to make an application to join the study.

To keep track of the numbers of families invited to apply to the E-SEE study we need you to fill out this 'application log'. This will help the central research team at the University of York calculate an accurate response rate and study sample size. To complete the log, use the sheet over the page to note each time you provide antenatal information or help a family complete an application, noting the baby age, the postcode and parental decision. Remember the logs will evidence your role in contributing to this important research and will provide important information needed for establishing an accurate response rate and study sample size.

By completing the E-SEE application forms mothers and fathers indicate permission for you to pass on their details to the research team. If mothers share their parenting role with someone who is also interested in study participation, please provide them with an additional application form (a co-parent application) for this person.
